Hello everyone, I'm "Water Save Dave", the Mascot of WSD and the spokesperson of "Cherish Water Campus"! Welcome everyone for joining the "Cherish Water Campus" and I hope all of you would share the message of water conservation with your friends and relatives.

We had a great "Cherish Water Campus" Pledging Ceremony at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University at the beginning of 2016. More than 300 representatives from school sponsoring bodies, primary school principals, teachers and students joined hands and made a mass water conservation pledge to use water wisely.

The ceremony was rich in content and filled with a variety of performances. It started with Miss Wu Chi Ching Esther, a student from the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts (HKAPA) performing her melodic water conservation song with three other HKAPA students. The song, composed, arranged and written all by Esther herself, encourages water conservation practices in our daily life. The HKAPA students' performance was followed by Miss Lam Yi Ning Elaine, sharing her experience in visiting water-scarce areas in the Mainland. Elaine's sharing reflected on everybody's responsibility not to consume water more than necessary. Lion dances were then performed along with the Water Supplies Department's new mascot "Water Save Dave" making its first public debut.

The ceremony reached a climax when our guests of honour, Permanent Secretary for Development Mr Hon Chi Keung, Undersecretary for the Environment Ms Loh Kung Wai Christine, Deputy Secretary for Education Dr Chan Ka Ki Catherine, Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Water Supplies Dr Chan Hon Fai and our "Star Principal" Director of Water Supplies Mr Lam Tin Sing Enoch joined hands with all participants to perform a card stunt to create a huge collage of "Cherish Water Campus" with everyone reading out "Start from Cherish Water Campus, join hands to nurture a water saving culture among the new generation!". The slogan embraces the spirit of "Cherish Water Campus", signifying a strong commitment to youth education on water conservation to help build Hong Kong a water-smart city.

Game booths were also set up at the venue where students played games and collected souvenirs while learning about water resources, water conservation and water sustainability.

Comprehensive learning on water conservation - To know and to practise

Interview with the SKH Holy Cross Primary School : Principal Chan Chung Hong, Mr Lee Kwun Yung

When we speak of "water rationing", surely it will arouse the memories of the older generation in Hong Kong. It may however be just a term in the history textbook for the younger generation. Since they have never experienced the difficult times in the water rationing days, they may not appreciate the importance of water conservation. With that in mind, SKH Holy Cross Primary School participates in "Cherish Water Campus" Integrated Education Programme (IEP) organised by the WSD, aiming to nurture students' water-saving habits and good water use practices of "not using more than necessary".

Principal Mr Chan Chung Hong said that as students had access to clean potable water at all times, they might take it for granted and would not appreciate the global water scarcity problem. "When they brush their teeth, they often just keep the water running without appreciating this is a waste of water." Mr Chan hopes his students can learn to treasure water and save every drop they can through IEP activities. There are wide-ranging topics in IEP relating to water resources and schools can flexibly choose topics that best suit their students' educational needs. The kit can also help reduce the time teachers spend on lesson planning or activity preparation. "The teaching kit provided by the Water Supplies Department comprises worksheets, activity teaching tools, short videos, etc. It is very comprehensive. Not only does it provide great convenience, it also makes water conservation related lessons and activities more interesting. Students are now keen to learn about water resources. The kit is an excellent and efficient resource for teaching and learning water conservation," said Mr Chan.



Mr Lee Kwun Yung

Mr Lee Kwun Yung, the teacher in charge of the green group in the school, has organised various activities based on the IEP to enable students to gain practical knowledge about water resources. School water audits are an example, through which students can observe different types of water taps to get to know more about their relative consumption. "When our students turn on the water tap, they would not take note of the varying flow rate in different types of water taps. For instance, the sensor type water tap only releases water on detecting users' hands and as soon as they remove their hands, it stops the flow hence saving water," said Mr Lee. He also added that observational and practical activities could inspire students to adopt a correct water use attitude in their daily life.


