## Objective:

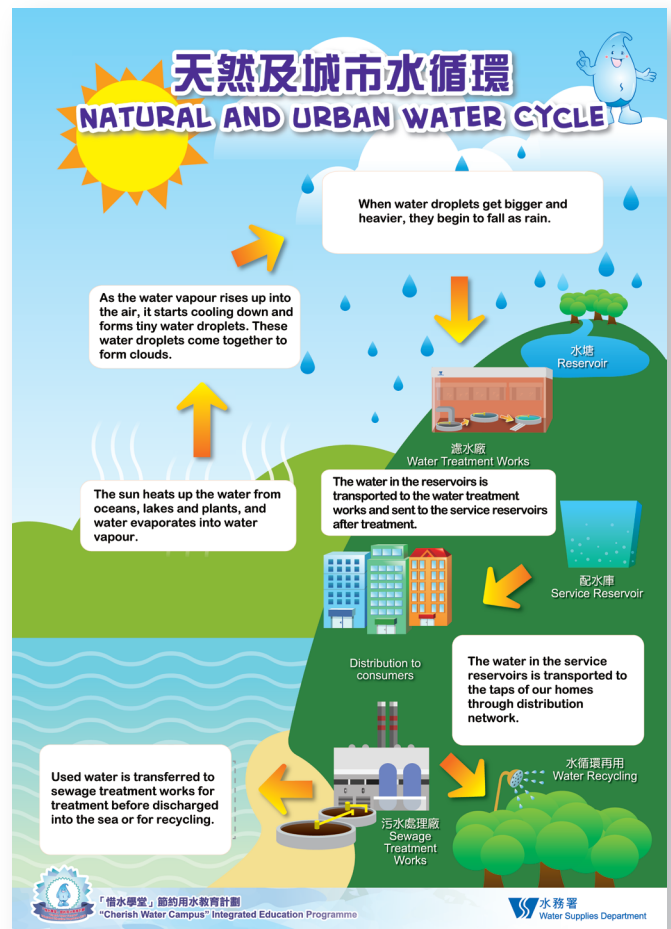
## \* Reference materials \*

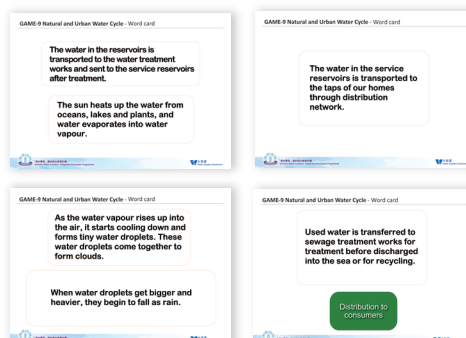
