

Game-13 Experiencing Water Shortage

Objective:

Living in an abundant environment in Hong Kong, it is hard to imagine a life experiencing water shortage. Therefore, this game aims to emphasize the importance of water resources by showing the negative impacts of water shortage on our lives. Students are also encouraged to reflect on their daily water use habits and make improvements where necessary.
