

# Game-18 Studying a Water Meter

## Objective:

Since 1932, the Hong Kong Government has been fully implementing the Metering System to measure the water consumption per household and to charge accordingly. Photos of water meters are displayed with a brief introduction of how to read the information on a water meter, including the meter number and the water consumption. Students can gain a fundamental understanding of reading a water meter.

## How to play:

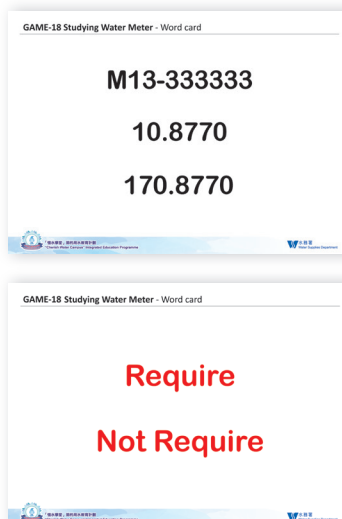
