

Meter Reading Guidelines

1. Readings of water meters are in cubic meters (m^3).
2. The digits in white on red backgrounds represent the decimal figures, whereas the digits in black on a white backgrounds represent numerals of digits in cubic meters.
3. When recording down the readings in worksheet nos. 9 and 10, make sure to write down all digits with the decimal point clearly. This is the reading in cubic meters.

Example 1:



The reading is $1.1992m^3$

Please write down 0001.1992 in the worksheets.

Example 2:



The reading is $3627.292m^3$

Please write down 03627.292 in the worksheets.
